



**Position: Bergmann Project Teaching Artist for Clarinet and Saxophone**

**Statement of the Job:** Elemental Music is celebrating its fifteenth season as one of Santa Monica's most treasured music training organizations. Elemental Music has served the community by providing high quality music instruction that inspires young musicians to invest and engage in music-making. Over 1,200 students have been part of our programs.

The Elemental Music Bergmann Project provides private instruction to local socio-economically disadvantaged students, from elementary through high school, on Saturday afternoons at the Santa Monica College Performing Arts Campus. These classes will be made possible, in part, through funding from the Peggy Bergmann Arts Endowment Fund. We are looking for specialists to work with these wonderful students on the clarinet, bass clarinet, and/or saxophone. The level of these lessons will range from elementary school-aged beginners through advanced high school students.

**Essential Duties:** Teaching artists will be responsible for providing private instruction to students ranging between 4<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades. All lessons will take place on Saturdays in Santa Monica, timing is flexible.

**Requirements:**

- A minimum of a Bachelor degree in Music Performance or Music Education (or equivalent experience)
- Experience working with students between ages 8-18
- Strong communication skills, both verbal and written, which may be required to speak with parents, or correspond via email
- Good time management skills
- Ability to work with diverse personalities and ability levels
- Spanish speaker is a plus!

This position will be paid at an hourly rate of \$55.
